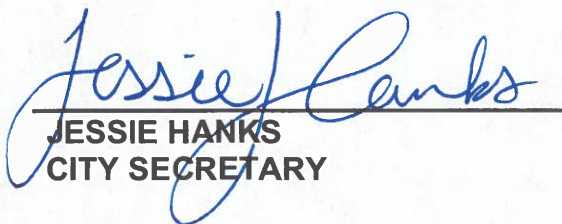

WHEREAS, the members of the Kaufman Police Department play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the citizens of Kaufman; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and understand the problems, duties, and responsibilities of their police department, and that members of our police department recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, by protecting them against violence or disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression or intimidation; and

**CITY OF KAUFMAN, TEXAS
ORDINANCE NO. O-09-23**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KAUFMAN, TEXAS CANVASSING THE RETURNS, INCLUDING THE RETURNS OF EARLY VOTING BALLOTS CAST IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE JOINT SPECIAL ELECTION BETWEEN THE CITY OF KAUFMAN ("CITY") AND KAUFMAN COUNTY ("COUNTY") HELD ON MAY 6, 2023, AS SUCH RETURNS RELATE TO A SPECIAL ELECTION SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS A PROPOSITION FOR THE REAUTHORIZATION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT (0.25%) TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING FOR THE CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT AND NOTICE TO COMPTROLLER FOR PROPOSITION A, SALES TAX; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on or about January 23, 2023, the City Council of the City of Kaufman, Texas (the "City") passed and approved Ordinance No. O-02-23, ordering a joint Special Election between the City of Kaufman ("City") and Kaufman County ("County") held on May 6, 2023, as such returns relate to the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) to provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-02-23 also ordered the appointment of a Presiding Election Judge and an Alternate Presiding Election Judge for the purpose of conducting such election; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate authority of the City heretofore caused to be posted and published, in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, a notice of the Special Election; and

WHEREAS, it appears that a total of 209 votes were cast in such an election; and

WHEREAS, the Joint General and Special Election were duly and legally held on May 6, 2023, in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the Joint Special Election, including the early voting results, have been certified and returned to the proper judges and clerks thereof; and

WHEREAS, the official returns of the presiding judges of the Joint Special Election, including the returns of early voting ballots in connection therewith, as such returns are related to the Special Election for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) to

provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the returns of the Joint Special Election as related to the Special Election for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) for a period of ten (10) years to provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the Special Election on a measure, including the returns of the early voting ballots, duly and legally made, showed that Proposition A related to reauthorizing a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) for a period of ten (10) years to provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets, received the following votes:

The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Kaufman, Texas at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. The tax expires on the 10th anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of the tax is reauthorized. WHEREAS, pursuant to State Law, if a majority of the qualified voters voting on a proposed measure vote in favor thereof, such measure shall become effective in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KAUFMAN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1
INCORPORATION OF PREMISES

The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2
CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATIONS

The results of the Joint Special Election for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) for a period of ten (10) years to provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets as canvassed and tabulated above, reflect the expressed desires of the resident, qualified voters of the City.

SECTION 3
PROPOSITION A – Sales Tax

In accordance with the canvass and tabulation of the results of the Special Election, Proposition A, “Sales Tax” was approved by a majority of qualified voters by a vote of 168 in favor to 41 opposed. The number of votes by which Proposition A was approved: 168.

SECTION 4
ISSUANCE OF CANVASS OF JOINT SPECIAL ELECTIONS

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Canvass of the Joint Special Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, and to take all other action necessary in connection therewith.

SECTION 5
ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT AND NOTICE TO COMPTROLLER FOR PROPOSITION A, SALES TAX

The City Secretary of the City of Kaufman is hereby directed to engross and enroll this Ordinance by copying the Caption and Effective Date in the minutes of the City Council and by filing this Ordinance in the ordinance records of the City. Further, the City Secretary shall notify the State Comptroller of the results of the election on the measure to reauthorize a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth of one percent (0.25%) to provide revenue for the maintenance and repair of municipal streets for a period of ten (10) years from the May 6, 2023 Joint Special Election. The City Secretary shall send such notice via certified mail to the Texas Comptroller along with a certified copy of this Ordinance and a map showing the boundaries of the City.

SECTION 6
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council of the City of Kaufman that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of

competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION 7
EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its date of passage in accordance with law, and it is so ordained.
