CALL MEETING TO ORDER Mayor calls the Meeting to order, states the date and time, state Councilmembers present, and declares a quorum present.

Mayor Jordan called the City Council meeting to order at 10:08 AM. Councilmembers present were Patty Patterson, Carole Aga, Charles Gillenwater, Jeff Council, and Jeff Jordan. Mayor Jordan declared a quorum present. Also present were City Manager Mike Slye, Assistant City Manager Mike Holder, City Attorney Patricia Adams, and City Secretary Jessie Hanks.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

1. Consider and take appropriate action on the Second Declaration regarding Local State of Disaster sue to Public Health Emergency; and providing a penalty for violations hereof.

Mr. Slye outlined the purpose on the declaration to require masks in the commercial industry and in public. He updated the Council on the county and state orders also requiring masks. He reviewed the penalties associated with the different declarations.

Councilmember Gillenwater made a motion to to adopt Ordinance No. O-15-20, an ordinance amending the City Council of the City of Kaufman, Texas Second Declaration Regarding Local State of Disaster due to public health emergency and the Second Mayoral Declaration regarding local state of Disaster due to public health emergency by amending Section 2, Health and Safety Plan – Commercial Entities”, Section 3, “Face Coverings – General Public”, Section 4, “Face Coverings Do not need to be worn in the following circumstances”, Section 7, “No penalty on individuals” and Section 9, “Penalty” in order to provide for a class C violation for individuals and fine up to \$250.00 to be consistent with Executive Order GA 29 and to the extent that there is a conflict between the City and Mayoral Declaration, GA 29 will supersede. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Patterson and passed 5/0.

There being no further business, Mayor Jordan adjourned the meeting at 10:29 AM.
