**CALL MEETING TO ORDER** Mayor calls the Meeting to order, states the date and time, state Councilmembers present, and declares a quorum present.\*\*

Mayor Pro-Tem Patterson called the City Council meeting to order at 8:09 AM. Councilmembers present were Carole Aga, Patty Patterson, Charles Gillenwater, Matt Phillips, Jeff Council. Councilmember Barry Ratcliffe joined the meeting at 8:13 AM. Mayor Pro-Tem Patterson declared a quorum present. Also present were City Manager Mike Slye, Assistant City Manager Mike Holder, City Attorney Patricia Adams, and City Secretary Jessie Hanks.

**DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS**

1. First Reading: Consider and take appropriate action on Ordinance O-31-20, an ordinance of the City of Kaufman, Texas, granting a franchise agreement for the collection and disposal of garbage, trash, brush and bulk in the City of Kaufman, Texas to Republic Services.

Mr. Slye outlined the process for approving a franchise agreement. He reviewed the agreement and the action Council would be considering. He informed Council about the transition plans which will occur in February, and the changes between the current service and the new agreement. He outlined the fees associated with the new agreement.

Councilmember Ratcliffe made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance O-31-20 granting a franchise agreement for the collection and disposal of garbage, trash, brush and bulk in the City of Kaufman, Texas to Republic Services. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Aga and passed 6/0.
